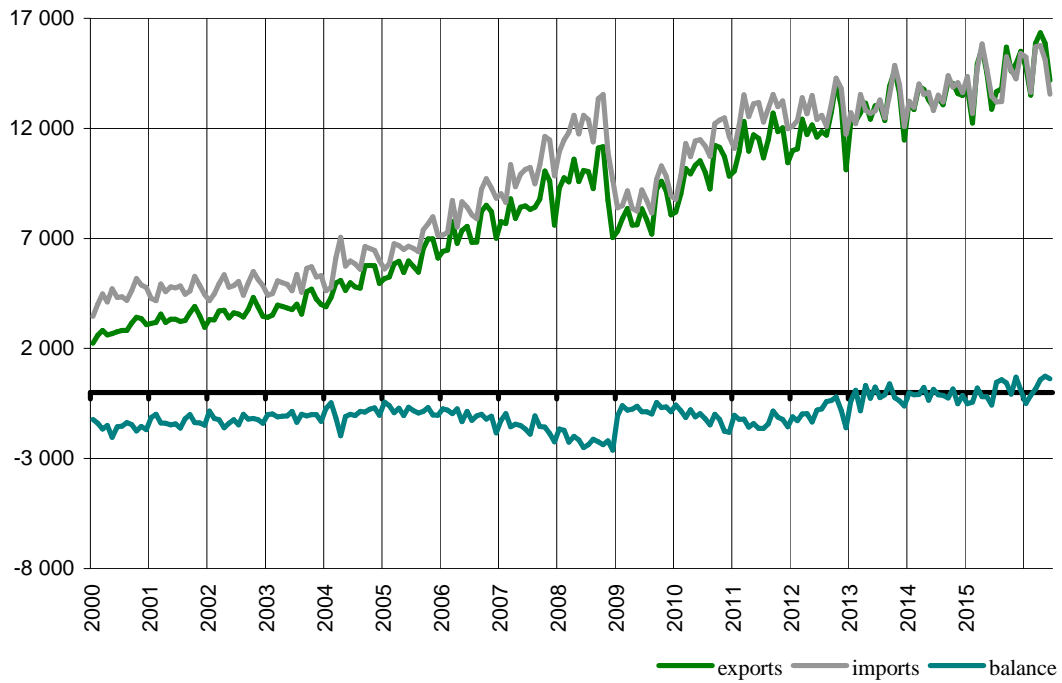

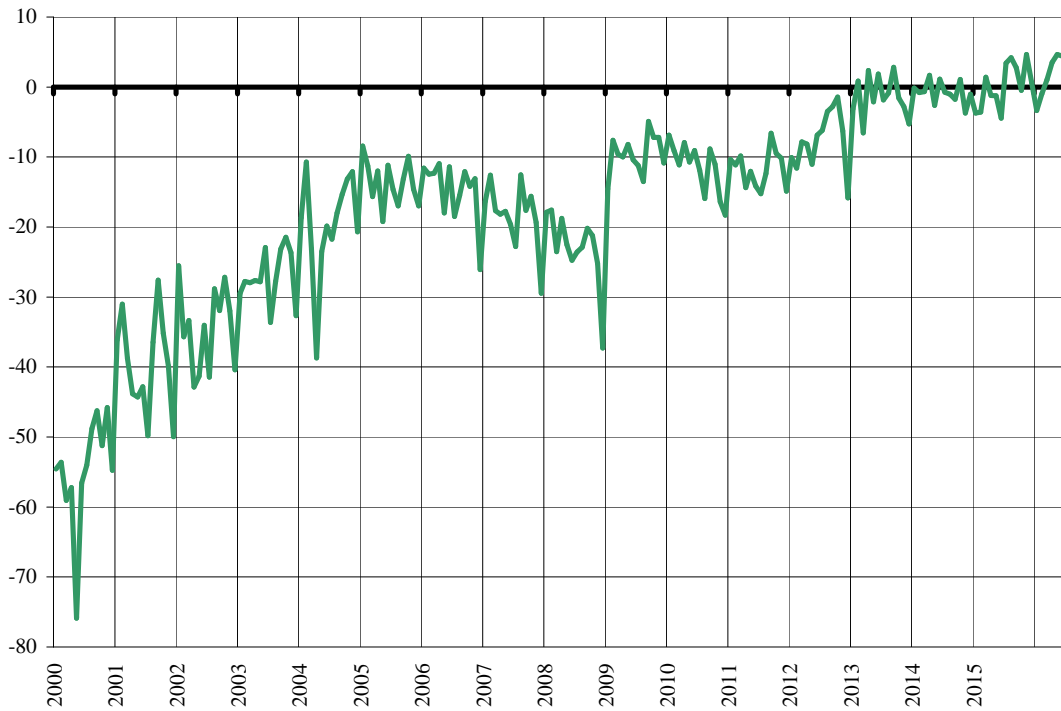

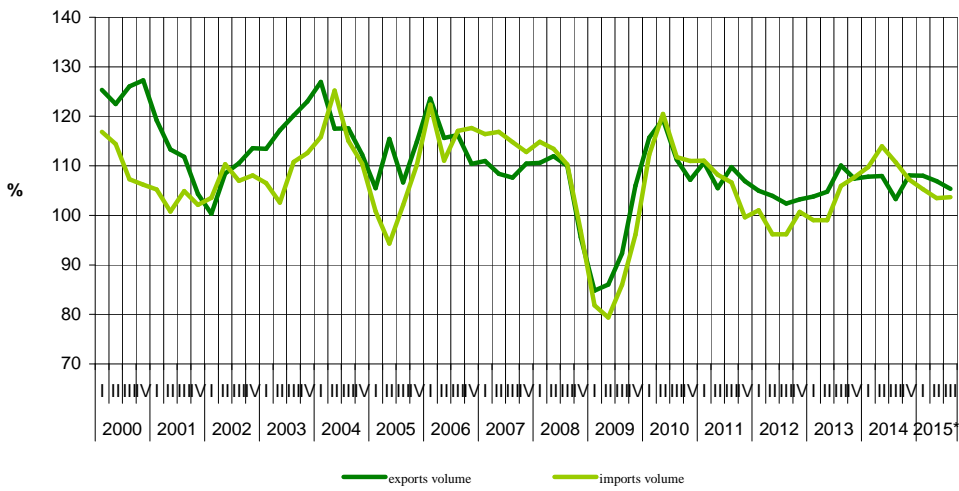

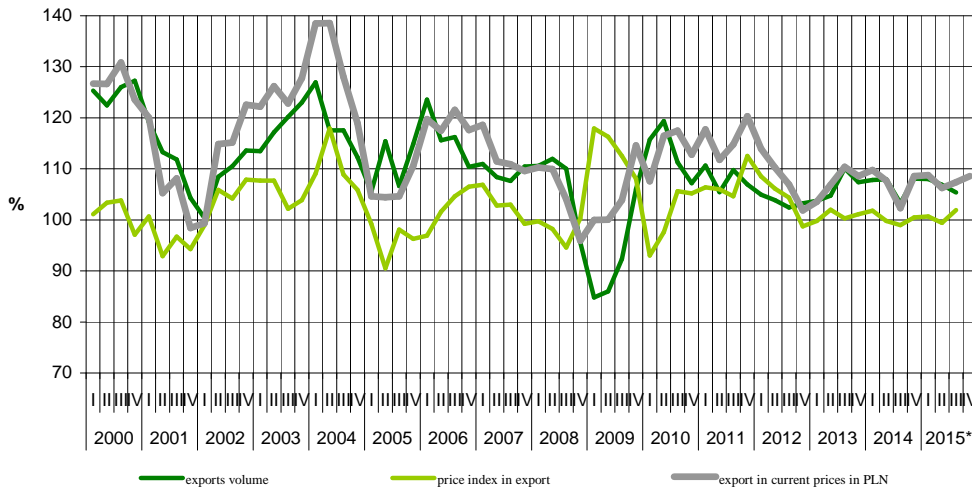

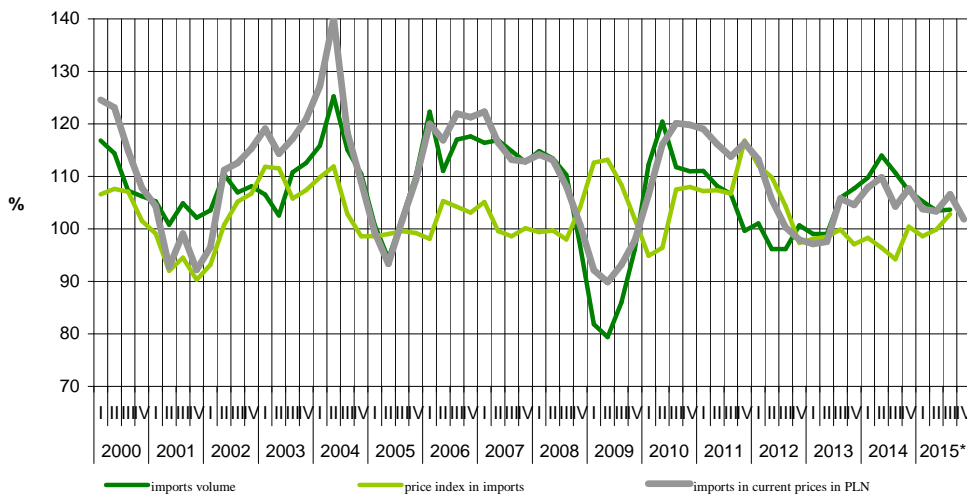
**Quarterly changes of polish foreign trade turnover (year on year)**

**Quarterly changes of Polish imports volume (year on year)**

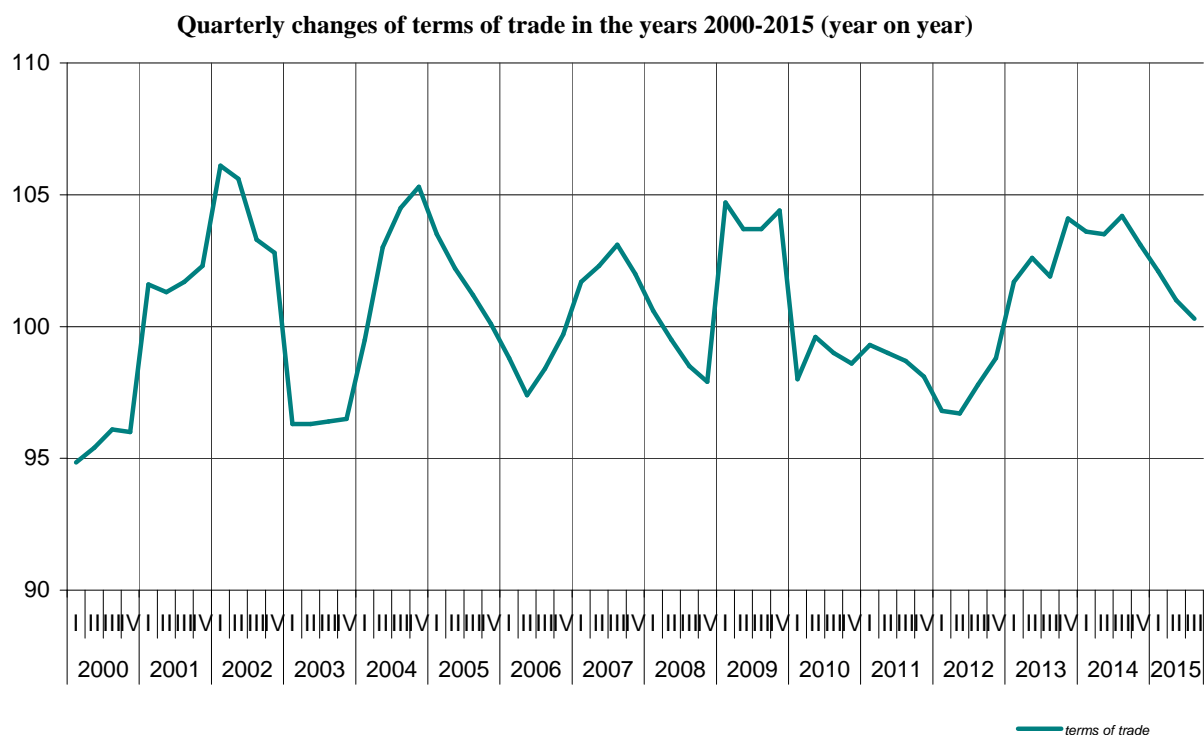

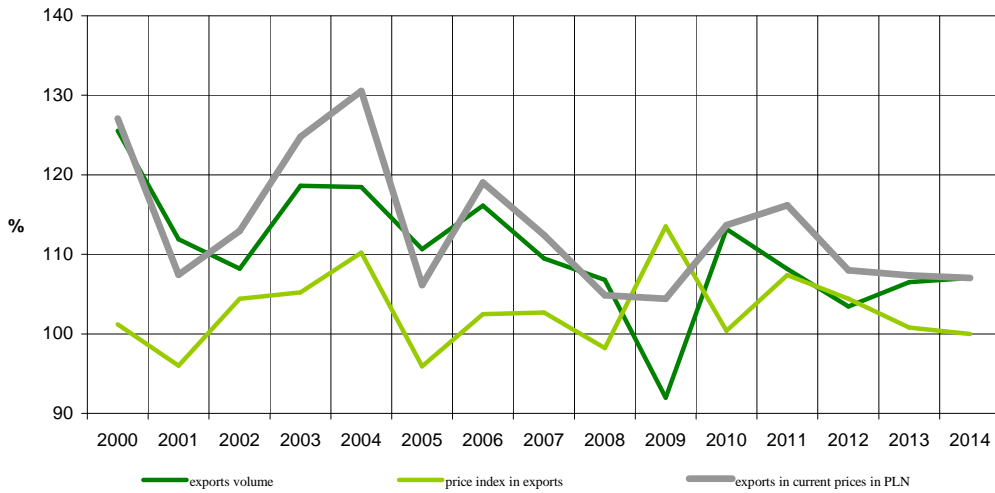

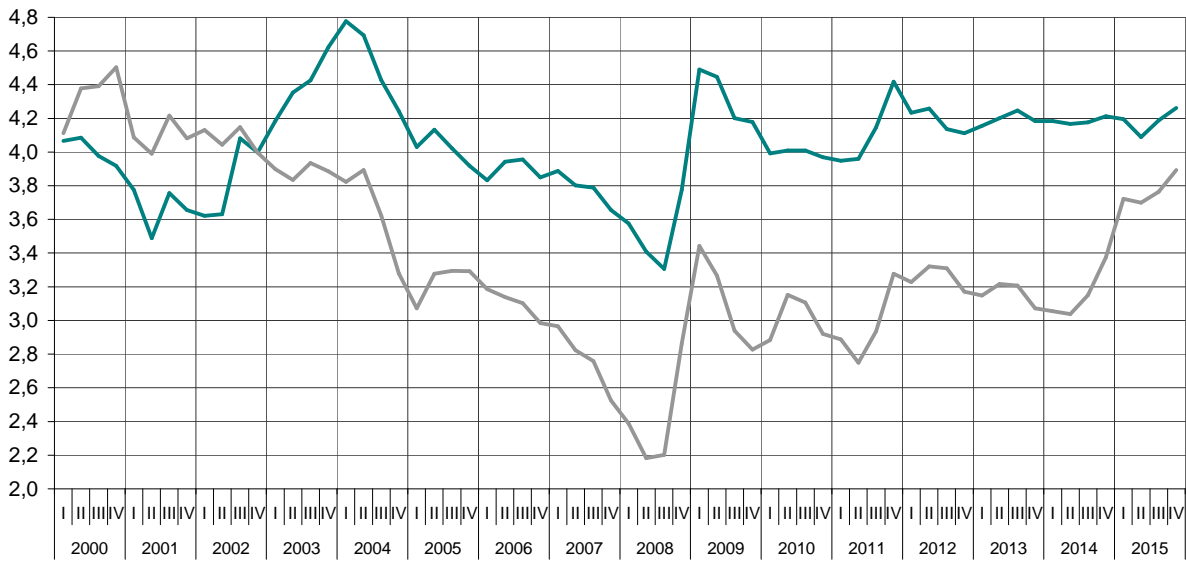

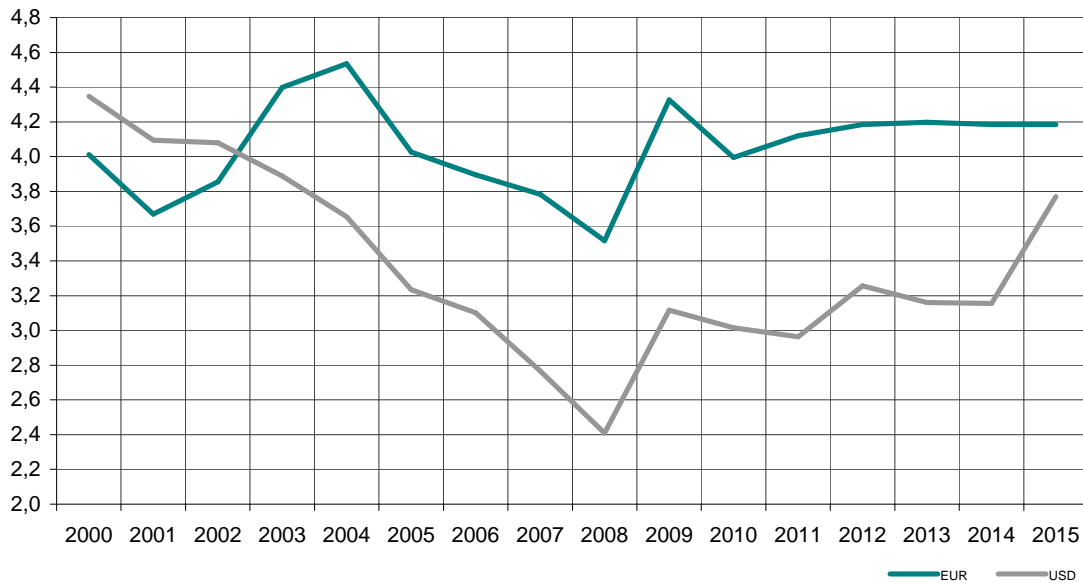

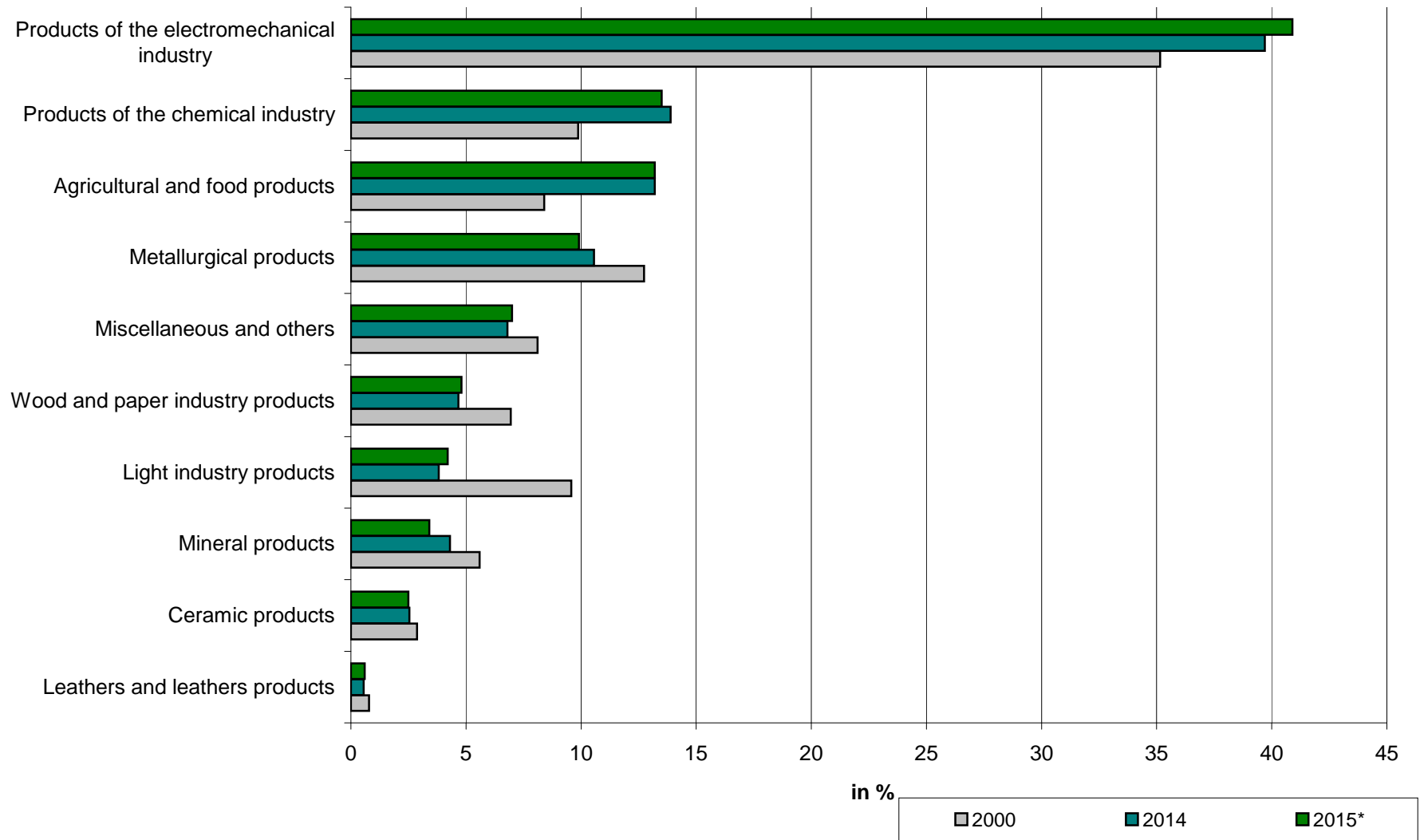

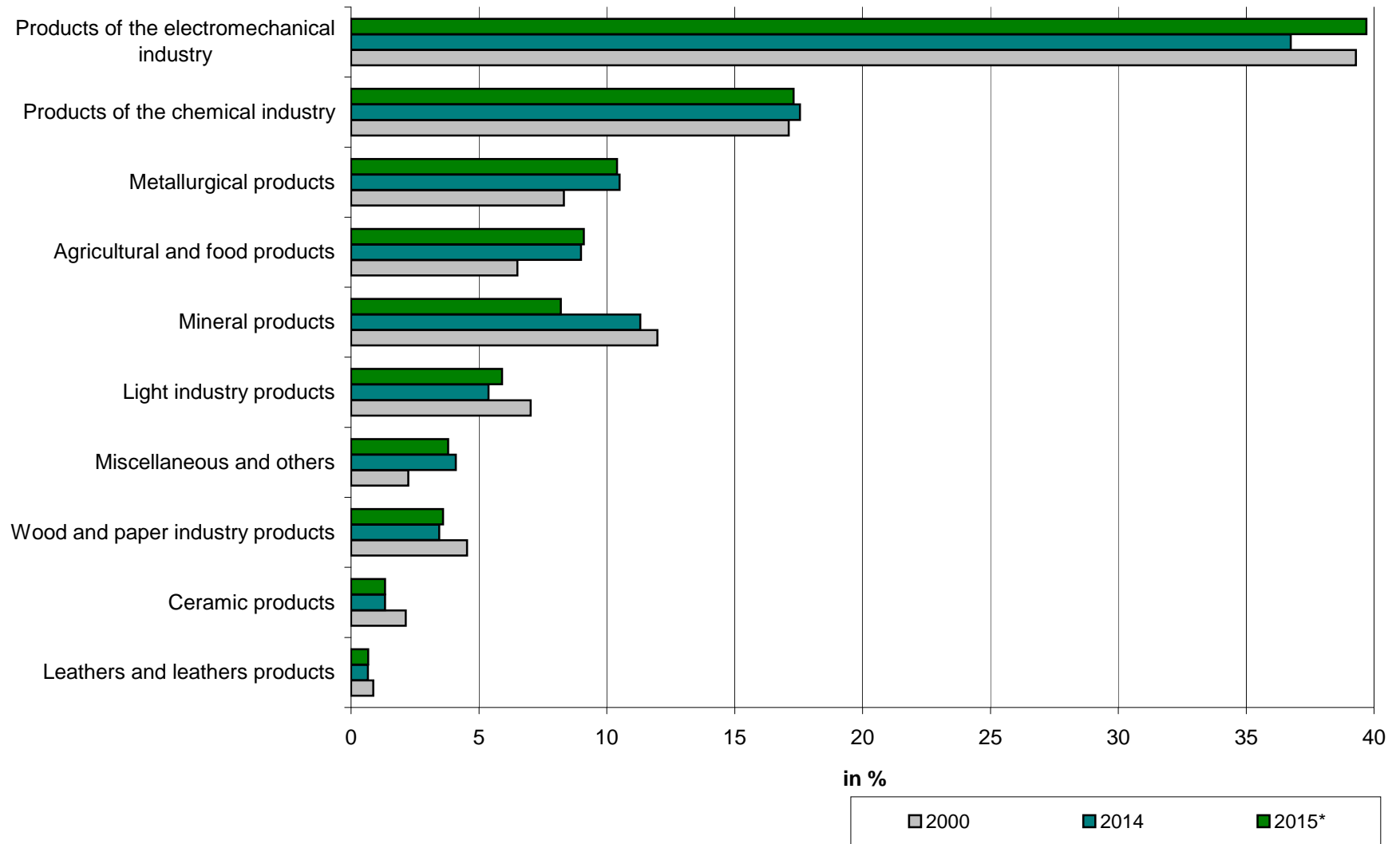
**Changes in the commodity structure of Polish exports in the years 2000-2015**

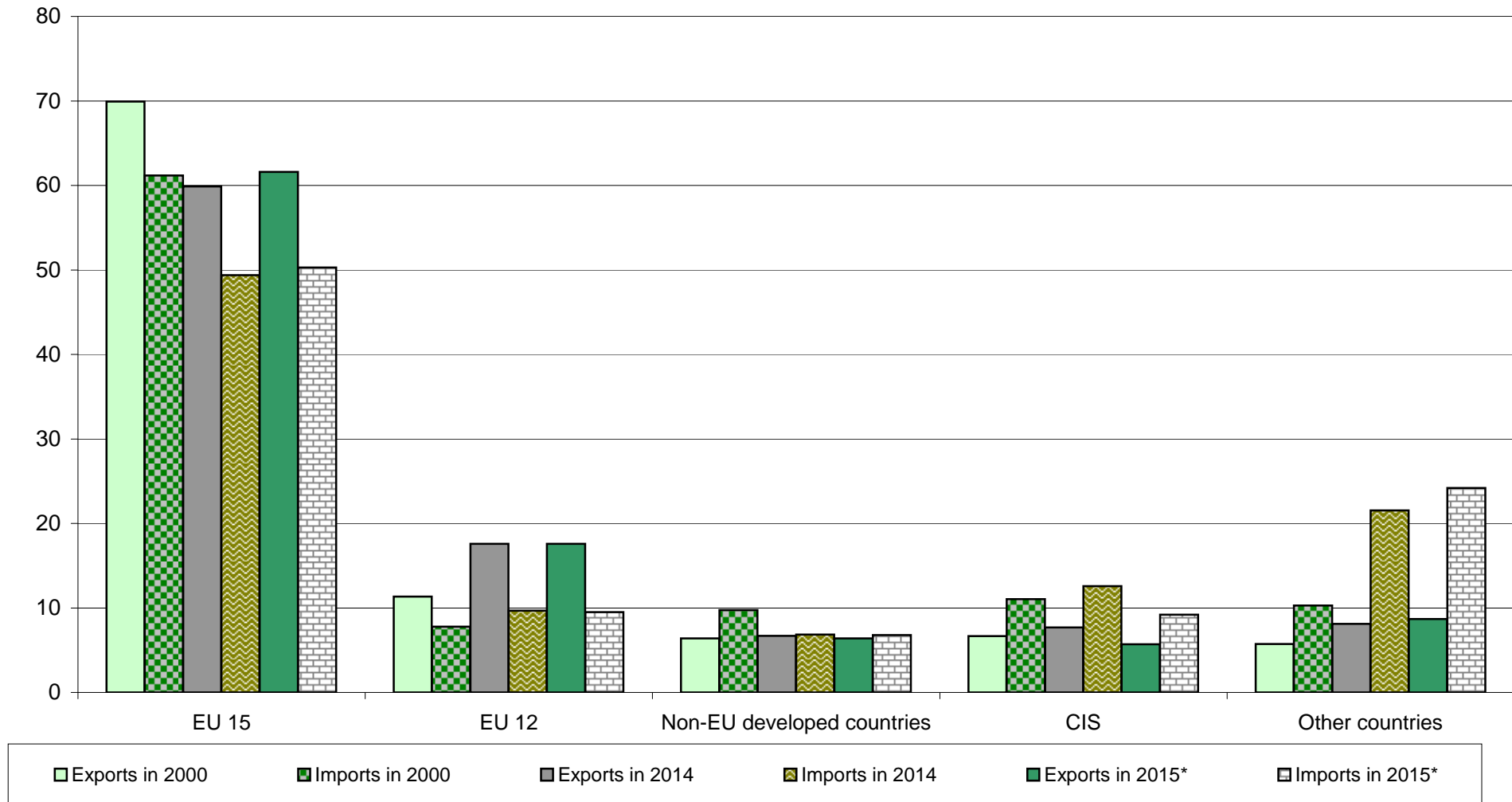
